The role of the intern

- to combine theory and practice by undertaking applied analytical tasks
- to get hands-on experience from working in a firm/organisation
- to work independently

The role of Aalborg University

- to help ensure that the intern benefits as much from the internship as possible
- to help ensure that the host organisation benefits as much from the internship as possible
- to clarify the mutual expectations of intern and host through an internship contract, setting out the main tasks in advance

The role of the host organisation

- to establish a suitable framework for the internship in terms workspace and supportive colleagues
 - to provide suitable tasks of an interesting and challenging nature that can further the professional development of the intern
- to allow the intern time to prepare for the written assignment during the internship
